

## Code of Conduct for Students

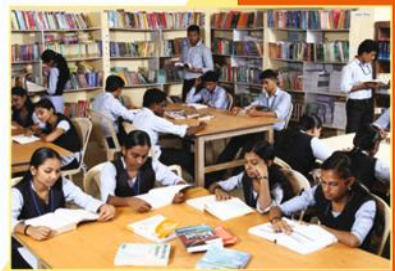

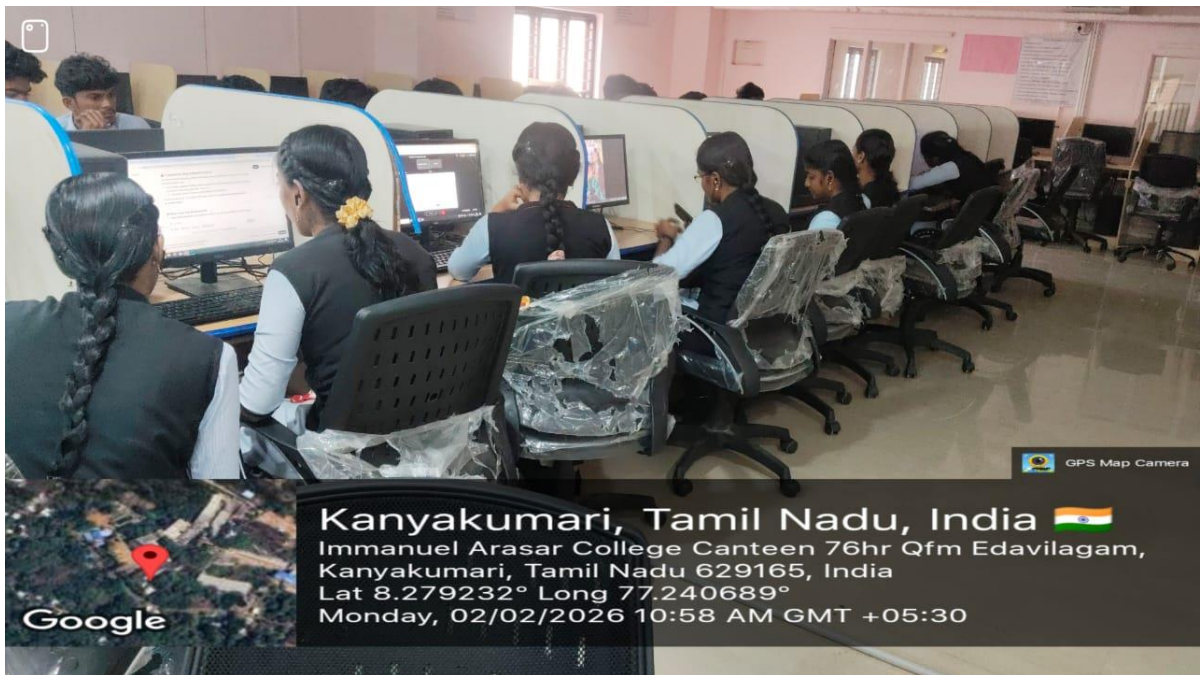
